Therefore, during our week in Alaska we will spend most of our time doing work projects assisting local craftsman as they help to improve the living conditions of Alaska locals. We'll be doing a lot of grunt work. Moving material, cleaning up work-sites and mixing concrete. As our Alaskan friends strive to improve their living conditions we will ease the burden of their bill by doing the heavy lifting. We hope our work will be a blessing to them, their families and the entire Kenai Peninsula as a whole. Every major change starts will a small act of kindness and we will do our part to provide as many small acts as possible.

As a youth pastor of over ten years I've learned first-hand how a trip like this can positively affect, not only the community we are traveling to, but also our students as well. One of the many pleasures of my job is to watch the dozens of lives changed through trips like this every year. As we plan and prepare for our trip, we ask for your support. Each person must raise \$1,400 to cover the costs of transportation, lodging, food, construction and other materials.
