FOCUS VERSE: ACTS 17:23-30


 How do you respond to Pastor Kyle saying, "Christianity does not exist because of the Bible"? Have you thought of that before? Agree or disagree?

Answer it together.




Read + Reflect

Read Acts 17:24-29

- When you read this, how do you respond? Do you feel close or far from God right now?
- Does it ever seem like God plays "hide-and-seek with you?
- God calls us his "offspring" or his "kids". Paul says that this is proof that we don't serve an imaginary god, but a very real one. If you have one, share a recent experience about experiencing God in a real way.

The God who made the world and everything in it, this Master of sky and land, doesn't live in custom-made shrines or need the human race to run errands for him, as if he couldn't take care of himself. He makes the creatures; the creatures don't make him. Starting from scratch, he made the entire human race and made the earth hospitable, with plenty of time and space for living so we could seek after God, and not just grope around in the dark but actually find him. He doesn't play hide-and-seek with us. He's not remote; he's near. We live and move in him, can't get away from him! One of your poets said it well: 'We're the Godcreated.' Well, if we are the Godcreated, it doesn't make a lot of sense to think we could hire a sculptor to chisel a god out of stone for us, does it?

1 John 4:13-16
