Sermon Discussion Guide

Week 3

Christmas is a time to re-engage with the light that may be dimming.



Q: God shows favor to people who do not deserve it. Why do you think that is?

- Have you experienced God's favor in your own life? How so?
- Favor is the Greek word, charis, which means "goodwill freely given". Why do you think God desires to give grace to us?

FOCUS VERSE

Mary was greatly troubled at his words and wondered what kind of greeting this might be. But the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary; you have found favor with God. You will conceive and give birth to a son, and you are to call him Jesus. He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High. (Luke 1:29-32)

BRING IT TO LIGHT

Elizabeth and Zechariah felt cursed. Mary felt undeserving. The shepherds felt rejected by society.

- Which one do you most resonate with?
- The cast of characters that God chooses to tell the most important story through do not see themselves as leading characters. What does that tell you about who God uses?

READ IT ALOUD

But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid. I bring you good news that will cause great joy for all the people. Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is the Messiah, the Lord." (Luke 2:10-11)

- Fear is the first response the shepherds. (and Mary) have to God's grace. What does this tell you about how we might perceive "favor" in our own lives?
- Our Savior came as an ordinary baby. Why do you think the light of the world came this way?

Recognize what you need: a Savior just for you. We can't be good enough to be good with God. -Pastor Kyle
