ONE-MINUTE RECAP

Pastor Kyle helped us see our relationships a little bit clearer. "We don't want to work on our relationships; we just want them to work." Relationships can be complex because each of us brings 'relational dreams' with us. However, these dreams can become demands, which he called a 'suitcase of unmet expectations.' When that happens, we enter into a debt/debtor relationship where we keep score and begin to feel like we are owed more than we have to give.

LEARN - READ OUTLOUD- JOHN 13:34

DISCUSSION VERSE:

A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another.

When faced with unmet relational dreams, what is your initial response:

To leave? (The argument, the problem, the room, the relationship) **To win?** (To fight, get louder, coerce, convict, or control) **To conform or compromise?** (To settle, give up, remain committed to the relationship but not the person in it.)

In the Christian tradition, *love is a race to the back of the line*. Jesus came to serve and not be served. This is a wildly different perspective on relational dreams than we are used to.



What happy couples know: "Owe each other everything, but expect nothing." How do you think you could implement this idea in your current relationship?
