## WHAT IS BAPTISM?

- Baptism is a declaration that you want to follow Jesus and are doing your best to figure out how to do that.
- 2 It is an ancient symbol and practice in the Christian church that says you are being made new by Jesus and that you believe He loves you and died for your sins.
- Baptism tells our community that you are seeking what it means to follow Jesus, and we get the joy of celebrating that.

### WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR ME?

Baptism is a joyful declaration that Jesus has saved you, is changing you, and has given you new life. It's not about earning salvation—it's an act of obedience, surrender, and celebration.

For some, baptism is a public step of faith after already walking with Jesus. For others, it's their first bold declaration of belief, marking the beginning of their journey with Him. Either way, it's a beautiful moment of transformation and testimony.
